

GIRLS — SCHOOL UNIFORM

HAIRSTYLE: Hairstyles must be <u>simple and neat</u> and <u>appropriate</u> for school.

Hair adornments must be **simple** in nature, neat and black in colour.

No other colour is allowed.

Hair colour must be natural. Extreme and artificial hair colours is not permitted.

Braided hair must be simple and appropriate

BLOUSE: Blouse — available at **JADOO'S** Arima.

Blouse must be neat and tidy.

Students must wear their House Pin at all times on the left side of the blouse collar.

Blouse sleeves must not be folded at the end.

No Fitted Blouses.

VESTS: Vests must **NOT** be visible at the neckline. **White ONLY (NO PRINTS)**.

SKIRT: Skirt — available at **JADOO'S** Arima.

(N.B. Skirt is not to be altered to be fitting on the hips).

Skirt must be **3"** below the knee. **No tight fitting skirts.**

SOCKS: Colour — **PLAIN WHITE ONLY**.

Socks should not be folded under the soles of the feet and must be at least two inches

(2") above the ankle.

SHOE: Colour— PLAIN WHITE ONLY.

No stripes or other colours are acceptable.

No other colour is acceptable.

Students wearing shoes with stripes/ other markings will have their shoes spray-

painted.

Boots are not allowed.

JEWELLERY: Earrings: Only ONE pair of tiny (.5 cm), simple (gold or silver) stoppers

allowed.

Rings — No rings allowed. No nose rings.

Students, who persist in wearing jewelry after two warnings, said jewelry would be

confiscated and returned to parent/guardian.

Only Form 6 students will be allowed to wear school ring.

WRISTWATCH: A simple wristwatch **only** to be worn.

MAKEUP: Makeup is not allowed. No coloured lipstick, false eyelashes, eyeshadow.

No nail polish (colored). Removal of makeup will result before entry into the

classroom.

STUDENT ID: Student IDs are available at the school. Deans will provide information regarding the

cost of new or replacement badges

Student Identification Cards are MANDITORY and must be worn at all times


N.B. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE IN FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM AT ALL TIMES WHEN

BOYS — SCHOOL UNIFORM

HAIRSTYLE: Hairstyle should be simple.

No fancy markings.

Hair must be combed and well groomed. Extreme hairstyles and unkempt hair are not

acceptable.

Hair length should be no longer than 3 inches.

Lengths above this must be cut or plaited.

Hair styles must be combed and plaited or patted down.

Colour of hair must be natural. Facial hair must be short and neat. Students hairstyles

pertaining to religious reasons, must be accompanied by a formal letter from

parent/guardian.

SHIRT: Shirt— Available at JADOO'S Arima

Shirt must always be clean.

Students must wear their House Pin at all times on the left side of their shirt collar.

Shirt sleeves must not be rolled up.

Shirt must be worn in the trousers at all times. Shirt must be fully buttoned up at all times.

No fitted or short shirts.

TEE SHIRT: WHITE ONLY.

The sleeves of the Tee Shirt must be short enough to be tucked neatly under the shirt.

PRINTED TEE SHIRTS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

TROUSERS: No tight fitted trousers.

No penciling.

Trousers are available at JADOO'S Arima.

SOCKS: Colour — PLAIN BLACK ONLY. (4" to 6" above the ankle).

Socks are to be worn at all times.

BELT: Plain black belt with simple buckles.

SHOES: Colour — PLAIN BLACK ONLY.

No stripes or other colours. Students wearing shoes with stripes/other markings will have their shoes spray-painted. Students wearing incorrect shoes must have a written valid excuse from parent/guardian, which will only be allowed for a period of two

weeks.

No extension will be granted unless approved by principal.

JEWELLERY: No Earrings or Nose rings are allowed.

Jewelry is not allowed.

<u>Wristwatch</u>: — Simple wristwatch is the only jewelry that must be worn.
